ORDER FOR ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTAL BRIEF

In addition to the five-page supplemental briefs due from the parties on Monday, the Court would like to take Lyft up on its offer to provide additional information about the company's efforts to help its drivers in this time of crisis. Lyft should therefore file a separate brief on Monday (with any necessary supporting documentation) that provides specific and detailed answers to two questions. First, how is Lyft helping drivers who have symptoms consistent with COVID-19? (This question is not limited to drivers who have been diagnosed.) Second, how is Lyft helping other drivers (regardless of whether they are sick) whose income streams have been decimated as a result of the pandemic? This brief should contain no legal argument—just factual information about what Lyft is doing to alleviate the hardships being suffered by its drivers.
