JOINT NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT, MOTION TO SUSPEND ALL PRETRIAL DEADLINES, MOTION TO SUSPEND THE CALENDAR CALL, AND MOTION TO SUSPEND THE TRIAL DATE

Under Local Rule 16.4, Plaintiffs, by and through their undersigned counsel, and Defendants, by and through their undersigned Assistant U.S. Attorneys, hereby notify the Court that they have reached a proposed settlement of the claims in this case.
