# Orders of Rulemaking

#### Title 8—DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS Division 50—Division of Workers' Compensation Chapter 5—Determination of Disability

## **ORDER OF RULEMAKING**

By the authority vested in the Division of Workers' Compensation under section 287.650, RSMo 2016, the division adopts a rule as follows:

8 CSR 50-5.007 is adopted.

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed rule was published in the *Missouri Register* on March 1, 2021 (46 MoReg 440-444). The section with changes is reprinted here. This proposed rule becomes effective thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: The Division of Workers' Compensation received one (1) comment on the proposed rule.

COMMENT #1: Staff commented that a portion of the proposed rule published in the *Missouri Register* was not what was submitted by the division. The word "emergency" should not have been before "rule" in section (5).

RESPONSE AND EXPLANATION OF CHANGE: The division agrees with this change.

# 8 CSR 50-5.007 Evidence of Occupational Disease Exposure for First Responders

(5) The provisions of this rule shall cease to be in effect at the expiration of the state of emergency declared in Executive Order 20-19 (originally declared in Executive Order 20-02) or any successor executive order extending the state of emergency, whichever occurs later.

#### Title 12—DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE Division 10—Director of Revenue Chapter 2—Income Tax

## **ORDER OF RULEMAKING**

By the authority vested in the director of revenue under section 143.191.3(1), RSMo 2016, the director adopts a rule as follows:

#### 12 CSR 10-2.019 Determination of Withholding for Work Performed at Temporary Work Location is adopted.

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed rule was published in the *Missouri Register* on February 16, 2021 (46 MoReg 321-324). No changes have been made in the text of the proposed rule, so it is not reprinted here. This proposed rule becomes effective thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: The Missouri Department of Revenue received one (1) comment on the proposed rule from the Associated Industries of Missouri (AIM).

COMMENT: The Associated Industries of Missouri (AIM) commented that they would like an extension of the COVID-19 relief period.

RESPONSE: The department appreciates the comment from AIM and plans to address this concern in the near future.

#### Title 20—DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND INSURANCE Division 2220—State Board of Pharmacy Chapter 2—General Rules

## ORDER OF RULEMAKING

By the authority vested in the State Board of Pharmacy under section 338.140, RSMo Supp. 2020, the board adopts a rule as follows:

**20 CSR 2220-2.685** Standards of Operation for a Class Q: Charitable Pharmacy **is adopted**.

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed rule was published in the *Missouri Register* on March 1, 2021 (46 MoReg 465-466). No changes have been made in the text of the proposed rule, so it is not reprinted here. This proposed rule becomes effective thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: No comments were received.

#### Title 20—DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND INSURANCE Division 2235—State Committee of Psychologists Chapter 2—Licensure Requirements

## ORDER OF RULEMAKING

By the authority vested in the State Committee of Psychologists under section 337.050, RSMo Supp. 2020, the committee amends a rule as follows:

20 CSR 2235-2.001 Educational Requirements, Section 337.021, RSMo is amended.

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed amendment was published in the *Missouri Register* on March 15, 2021 (46 MoReg 509-510). No changes have been made in the text of the proposed amendment, so it is not reprinted here. This proposed amendment becomes effective thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.
